Material Specifications

Roof Weldment shall be made of 3-1/2" O.D. x 11 gauge galvanized tube, 2-3/8" O.D. x 12 gauge galvanized tube, and 11 gauge galvanized sheet steel. Post shall be made of 3-1/2" O.D. x 11 gauge galvanized tube. The roof panel shall be constructed of translucent colored polycarbonate. All fastening hardware shall be Fastener Style A. The frame shall have a Mira-Cote finish.
